

**SNEADS TOWN COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
MARCH 8, 2007**

The Town Council of the Town Of Sneads, Florida met in special session at the Sneads Town Hall on Thursday, March 8, 2007 at 5:01 p.m.

Jimmy L. Wright called the meeting to order with the following present:

The purpose of the special meeting was to give the citizenry an opportunity to become familiar with the proposed project and to comment on economic and environmental impacts, service area, alternatives to the project, as well as any other issues associated with the project. In addition, this was for Jim Dean, Area Director for Rural Development to present the Letter of Conditions for Phase II Funding for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Project to the Town Council and Public.

Evan McAllister displayed an overlay of the project which included the area to be served. Jim Dean presented the Letter of Conditions to the Council and the Public was given opportunity to make comments. There being no comments regarding the project from the public, Mike Weeks made a motion to proceed with execution of the necessary documentation to proceed with Phase II Funding. Donovan Weeks seconded. All voted aye.

Town Council discussed with Evan McAllister and Bill Nobles of Melvin Engineering the possibility of the Town constructing the waterline project to save money. After discussion, Mike Weeks made a motion authorizing Evan McAllister of Melvin Engineering to send a letter to Rural Development requesting the Town be allowed to construct the Motel Waterline Project. Donovan Weeks seconded. All voted aye.

Clerk presented Resolution #07-04 as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT, ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF SNEADS, FLORIDA, TO EXECUTE A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF SNEADS AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA, SETTING FORTH THE MAINTENANCE PROVISIONS, PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

Mike Weeks made a motion to accept Resolution #07-04 as presented. Greg Lewis seconded. All voted aye.

Mike Weeks told the Council that by next Tuesday the Town needed to prepare to advertise for a new City Manager. Council agreed.

Meeting adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
