

**SNEADS TOWN COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
MAY 15, 2007**

The Town Council of the Town Of Sneads, Florida met in special session at the Sneads Town Hall on Tuesday, May 15, 2007 at 5:00 p.m.

President Greg Lewis called the meeting to order with the following present:

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss issuing a "Letter Of Intent" to World Health Energy to construct a Bio-Diesel Plant at the Industrial Park Site located in Sneads. Ed Kilpatrick reviewed the "Letter Of Intent" with the Council.

Ed Kilpatrick read a letter from C.J. Lieberman to the Council stating that he intends to fund World Health Energy for this project. Mr. Kilpatrick then told the Council that he had Mr. Zhao's financial proposal for this project and the package is based on projections. Mr. Kilpatrick told the Council that he has done some research on the Company and explained to the Council some of the information received by World Health Energy at the previous workshop could not be verified. More discussion followed on the concern of the weakness of the Company and the Town should look for a business more financially sound and able to provide possibly more jobs with better pay rates. After discussion, Jimmy L. Wright made a motion not to approve the "Letter Of Intent" to World Health Energy, Inc.. Ricky Whittington seconded. All voted aye.

Donovan Weeks told the Council that there is a new rule stating that every fence at the Recreation Park under 6' high has to be crowned with pipe. The Town would need approximately 2,047 feet at a costs of \$1,700.00. Ed Kilpatrick told the Council he felt this could be done under renovations on the FRDAP IV Phase Grant

Ed Kilpatrick told the Council that he met with Harold Veitch of the Corps of Engineers and the Management Plan submitted for Sneads Park was submitted but not approved. Discussion followed on the need to repair the boat ramp and how this could be done.
