The Town Council of the Town Of Sneads, Florida met in a workshop meeting at the Sneads Town Hall on Wednesday, May 9, 2007 at 5:30 p.m.

The purpose of the workshop was to meet with Edwin Zhao and representatives of World Health Energy concerning building a Bio-Diesel Plant at the Industrial Park located in Sneads.

Mr. Zhao presented a presentation (See Attached) to the Council concerning World Health Energy and the future of Bio-Fuels. Mr. Zhao explained to the Council the three phases of construction for the project and once completed would employ approximately 60 employees at an approximate salary of \$25,000.00 per year for plant employees. Council then discussed with Mr. Zhao and representatives how bio-diesel would be shipped out, potable water needs, feed stocks and how much bio-diesel would be stored on site. David Melvin of Melvin Engineering asked Mr. Zhao about their financial condition for this project. Mr. Zhao told the Council they just closed funding and this would be their first Plant.

After presentation and discussion, Edwin Zhao told the Council that they needed to know if the Council was in favor of the Bio-Diesel Plant being built at the Industrial Park and if so would need a "Letter Of Conditions". Council agreed to meet again and get a consensus of the whole Council.
